Important points to remember:

Class Dress Code

Applicable for Performance Troupe Classes/Workshops and when required

- Backstreet Dancewear (at least one logo item) and matching clothes
 - Black, white, silver, gold, grey
- Hair neat and out of face
- No cleavage, bra straps, crop tops, exposing belly buttons or mini shorts
- No tattoos (even temporary), no excessive jewellery
- Dance shoes for class:
 - Senior Hip Hip Crew: Hip hop shoes (matching colours to uniform)
 - Junior Dance Club: This term: Hip hop shoes (matching colour to uniform)
 - Diva Squad: Black Jazz shoes

Class Commitment

High level of commitment required

- Compulsory to attend all classes, workshops and rehearsals
- If late – a text or call expected
 - Apologise to Teacher and group when walking in & join in
- If sick – determine if able to sit and watch or need to stay at home
 - Phone call is expected if sick
 - If miss more than 2 classes in a row, a private lesson may be required
- Be responsible in catching up and practicing at home
 - Film the Teacher; catch up with another dancer from the group
- Bring Journal, arrive early and be ready to dance

Student Behaviour

Professionalism is expected as you are required to be a leading example

- Speak and ask questions at appropriate times
- Support your fellow dancers and be positive AT ALL TIMES
- Listen, be focussed and ready to learn AT ALL TIMES

Communication

- Read text messages sent (there's a lot of love put into these detailed messages – all for your benefit)
- Keep up to date with the PERFORMANCE TROUPE page of the website

Performance Commitment

- MUST perform at least 7 out of 8 performances (this excludes Cairns Central & Term 3 Show)
- MUST commit to the whole week of Cairns Central or not perform at all during the week
